SUMMARY

Public International Call for Expressions of Interest for the Position of General
Director of the Archaeological Museum of Thessaloniki

- 1. The Board of Directors of the Archaeological Museum of Thessaloniki** announces a call for applications to fill the position of General Director (Articles 14, 15, 16, and 17 of Law 5021/2023, as amended and in force), for a three-year term, renewable, in accordance with Article 14(1) of Law 5021/2023 and Article 12(1) of Presidential Decree 39/2024.
- 2. Deadline – Submission Procedure:** Applications (including all supporting documents) must be submitted by 15-07-2026, either by registered mail or courier to the “Archaeological Museum of Thessaloniki,” Manoli Andronikou 6, P.C. 54621 (P.O. Box 506 19 and Thessaloniki Postal Code 540 13), or filed in person at the Museum’s Registry Office. In both cases, applications must be enclosed in a sealed envelope marked “Application for the position of General Director,” including the applicant’s full name, postal address, and email address.
- 3. General Qualifications of Candidates:** (a) Greek citizens or citizens of other EU Member States, or citizens of other countries provided they have excellent knowledge of the Greek language, (b) Fulfillment of the requirements for public appointment and absence of any disqualifications under Articles 5–10 of Law 3528/2007 (Government Gazette A’ 26/2007).
- 4. Specific Qualifications of Candidates:** (a) A university degree (from a Greek or foreign higher education institution) recognized by the competent authority or through professional equivalence recognition, in prehistoric and/or classical archaeology, (b) A doctoral degree from a Greek university or an equivalent recognized degree from abroad in archaeology, museology, or another field relevant

to the Museum's mission, character, and operation, (c) Proven excellent knowledge of Greek and at least very good knowledge of English or another official language of an EU Member State, in accordance with Law 4765/2021, as in force, (d) Publications of recognized and reputable scholarly work in Greece and internationally, (e) At least eight (8) years of successful organizational and administrative experience in a position of responsibility.
